Other ideas for donating produce:

- ☐ Gleaning: If you have food left over that you don't want or can't harvest you can let others know so they can help to harvest it. Every bit helps. Why waste your produce if it can be used by others.
- ☐ Put produce to be donated in a shaded/central spot for sharing with other gardeners or for donations. If needed to have another person deliver for you just send out an email to the group and ask for help.

- ☐ Post on your Facebook's Marketplace
- ☐ Check your local Community Center, some have food pantries
